


Q1: Role categories. Select one category which best describes your role in the firm. (Reference to solicitors includes Registered Foreign Lawyers).




Q2: Which age category are you in?






Q3: What is your sex?


Q4: Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?


Q5: Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?


Q6: Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?


Q7: How do you describe your ethnic group:


Q13: What is your religion or belief?


Q14: What is your sexual orientation?


Q15: Which type of school did you attend for the most time between the ages of 11 and 16?


Q16: Did either of your parents attend university and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?


